Ray Shipley is asked 'are you a boy or a girl?' by kids at the library at least once a month. With that in mind, He & She was born – Ray's debut solo comedy show exploring gender identity, relationships and social norms, all with tongue firmly in cheek. Loosely based on the advice of the 1958 Penguin Classic of the same name, He & She is an hour of anecdotal and observational comedy about living life in the grey areas between socially acceptable and not, polite conversation and existential crisis, and, as the title suggests, the grey area between he and she.

Ray Shipley (previously known as Sophie Rea) is a comedian and performance poet from Ōtautahi. Ray first attempted stand-up comedy only two years ago and since then has been awarded 'highly commended' at the national Raw Comedy Quest finals; Ray has firmly established a place as a key performer in the growing Christchurch comedy scene.
